SKI & BOARD

Grossarl Valley – Dorfgastein: 80 km of slopes, broad snowmaking coverage, 5 gondolas, 3 six- and 3 four-seater chair lifts, 2 double chair lifts, plus 6 tows and bunny lifts. Ski amade partner (270 lifts and 860 km of slopes).

Free ski bus throughout the Grossarl Valley and to Alpendorf (lifts to the Salzburg Sports World), 2 ski and snowboard schools in the Grossarl Valley, half pipe and fun park on the Kreuzkogel (8 obstacles), special events.

- Party program during Ladies' Ski Week.

NORDIC SPORTS

30 km of ski trails (Grossarl-Kösslerhäusl and Hüttschlag-valley head, 2 km of which is floodlit), new alpine trail on the Saukarkopf (4 km). cross-country school in Grossarl. Guided snowshoeing.

SKI TOURING

The Grossarl Valley is famous for the countless ski-touring opportunities its mountains offer in winter. The “Grossarl Valley Ski-Touring Guide” describes the valley’s 10 most popular tours. The “Berglandhaus” and “Himmelreich” are two tour options from the ski area itself.

ACTIVE WINTERS

25 km of winter hiking paths, incl. at the valley head, the Grossarl Valley Bike Path and Hirschgrubenalm-Hubalm. Hikes by torchlight, sledding (floodlit hill by the Lammwirt), ice skating, alpine curling (incl. tournaments), sleigh rides, hang- and paragliding.
