## SKI & BOARD

200 km of groomed hills ranging from easy to expert, incl. a World Cup downhill course on the Zwölferkogel. All major hills have snowmaking coverage (180 snowmakers!). Also possible to ski down to Viehhofen. Night slopes in Hintertglemm and Leogang. 55 lifts incl. 15 aerial tramways, 18 chair lifts, 22 tows, bunny lifts in Viehhofen and Maishofen.

Family Hill: the Hinterreit in Saalfelden with 2 tows and 1 bunny lift. Ideal, affordable family skiing. Training center for World Cup ski teams!

19 ski and snowboard schools: Saalbach, Hintertglemm, Mitterlengau, Schönleiten, Leogang, Saalfelden,

Viehhofen, Maishofen.

Fun Park in Hintertglemm, floodlit after dark, Leogang Fun Park (by the summit terminal on the Asitz). Perfect slopes for freeriding and carving.

## NORDIC SPORTS

10 km in Saalbach-Hintertglemm (1.7 km alpine trail on the Reiterkogel), 150 km network of trails in the Saalach Valley incl. Saalfelden, Leogang and Maishofen. Trail along the shores of the Ritzensee (Saalfelden), snowmakers available if needed. Cross-country schools in all communities.

Snowshoeing. Nordic Academy in Saalfelden, incl. intro to biathlon, snowshoe hikes and Nordic Walking.

## SKI TOURING

20 touring routes in the mountains of the Pinzgauer Grasberge, all levels of difficulty, over 100 km of deep-snow slopes, 80 km of pristine touring hills.

### TIPS:

- › Magical atmosphere at 40 alpine huts, high tea, dance nights and dance bars with live bands, bars, cafés.
- › Snow rafting (Leogang)
- › Snowshoeing on the Biberg
- › Ski museum in Saalbach, Pinzgau Museum with big exhibition of nativity scenes at Ritzen Castle (Saalfelden).

## ACTIVE WINTERS

115 km of winter hiking paths (on Lake Ritzensee in Saalfelden, for example). Hikes by torchlight, ice skating, 9 sledding hills (8 of which are under the lights after dark), alpine curling, sleigh rides. Archery trail and quad course in Viehhofen.
